

# *Bernard Silvester Sturrock*

*1894 – 1915*

*Lieutenant, 4<sup>th</sup> Battalion Black Watch (Royal Highlanders)*



Bernard (Birnie) Silvester Sturrock, Lieutenant, 4<sup>th</sup> Battalion Black Watch (Royal Highlanders) was the third son of James Silvester Sturrock W.S. and Josephine Lucy Florence Woolley, of Torduff House, Colinton.

He was born in Edinburgh, on 10<sup>th</sup> May 1894. Educated at Trinity College, Glenalmond, and the University of St. Andrew's, where he was a student in Law.

He was gazetted 2<sup>nd</sup> Lieutenant, 2<sup>nd</sup> September 1914, 4th (City of Dundee) Battalion, The Black Watch, and promoted Lieutenant, 21<sup>st</sup> June 1915.

He was killed in action in the Battle of Loos, France, 25<sup>th</sup> September 1915, aged 21.

He is Remembered with Honour at Loos Memorial, Glenalmond College, Broughty Ferry Cricket Club, and Lasswade Cemetery.
