Bernard Silvester Sturrock 1894 – 1915 Lieutenant, 4th Battalion Black Watch (Royal Highlanders)

Bernard (Birnie) Silvester Sturrock, Lieutenant, 4th Battalion Black Watch (Royal Highlanders) was the third son of James Silvester Sturrock W.S. and Josephine Lucy Florence Woolley, of Torduff House, Colinton.

He was born in Edinburgh, on 10th May 1894. Educated at Trinity College, Glenalmond, and the University of St. Andrew's, where he was a student in Law.

He was gazetted 2nd Lieutenant, 2nd September 1914, 4th (City of Dundee) Battalion, The Black Watch, and promoted Lieutenant, 21st June 1915.

He was killed in action in the Battle of Loos, France, 25th September 1915, aged 21.

He is Remembered with Honour at Loos Memorial, Glenalmond College, Broughty Ferry Cricket Club, and Lasswade Cemetery.
