Frederick Houghton Haden, 2nd Lieutenant, Rifle Brigade, was the son of the Reverend Frederick William Haden, a former Rector of St. Cuthbert's, Colinton, 1907-1910.



He was born in Stafford on 22nd March 1898. Educated at Mr. Tabor's School at Cheam and Winchester College. He went on to Radley where he won the Military Prize in 1916, and matriculated at Trinity College, Cambridge in the autumn of 1916 hoping to go up as soon as the war was over with the intention of being ordained.

He was gazetted to the 5th Rifle Brigade, and joined the 1st Battalion at the front in June 1917.

He was killed at Monchy-Le -Preux on 4th November 1917, aged 19, while serving with a trench mortar battery.

He is Remembered with Honour at Monchy British Cemetery, Winchester College, and Trinity College, Cambridge.
